

## **Ratan Tata Honoured**

Ratan Tata, Chairman of the Tata Group, has been made an Honorary Doctor of Law by the University of Cambridge in recognition of his business achievements and philanthropic work. The degree was conferred on him at a traditional and formal ceremony presided over by the Duke of Edinburgh, Prince Philip, who is also the Chancellor of the University.

The citation read out by the University Orator described him “as a modest and private man, never slow to adopt new ways of doing business, nor to enter new markets and take his business into foreign countries. His model and exemplar is his great-grandfather Jamsetji Tata who inspired his descendants to philanthropy with the philosophy that they should give back to the people what they have earned from them”.
